When you graduate, you'll be prepared to pursue employment opportunities in a childcare centre, preschool, family day home or elementary school setting.

Complete The ECE Certificate of Achievement which consists of 3 courses that qualify you to apply for Level 1 Certification from the Ministry of Education OR work towards obtaining your ECE Diploma on a part-time basis.

You'll need Grade 12 with English Language Arts A30 and B30. Prerequisites may be required for some courses.

You'll be required to provide evidence of a Criminal Record Check prior to entering practicum placements.

The College's original name, Carlton Trail Community College, was selected through a contest, with the winning entry tying the institution's name to the region's history. The Carlton Trail was an important transportation corridor for people, goods, services and information during the early days of settlement.

Your first step to a career in business, government, healthcare, or another sector starts with the Office Administration Certificate.

Get training on the most up-to-date aspects of office administration. Learn about keyboarding, writing, basic accounting, reception, communication, records management, scheduling, and more. Plus, you'll develop your computer skills in word processing, spreadsheets, databases, presentations, and automated accounting. Practice in class, then develop your skills further during the work experience component.

When you graduate, you'll be prepared to enter the workforce as a receptionist, administrative assistant, customer service representative, bookkeeper or other position that requires office administration skills.

This program is approximately 35 weeks long.

Continuing Care Assistants (CCAs) are one of the top 5 occupations in Saskatchewan. According to the Ministry of Immigration and Career Training (February 2023), there were 668 vacancies in the CTC region and 4,470 in the province.

Learn how to support clients who depend on you. Topics covered include gerontology, dementia management, performing personal care, medication monitoring, and more. You'll also receive Standard First Aid / CPR C / AED training or equivalent, WHMIS training, and participate in a clinical work experience.

When you graduate, you'll be prepared to pursue one of the hundreds of employment opportunities available for CCA's in long-term care, private-care, homecare, and other healthcare settings.

This program is approximately 32 weeks long.

You'll need Grade 12 and/or successful completion of 15 post-secondary credits from a recognized institution & English Language Requirement. You'll also be required to provide evidence of a Criminal Record Check, a Vulnerable Sector Search and immunization records to meet program requirements.

Practical Nurses are in high demand! If you want to help people and have a career with many opportunities, consider becoming a Practical Nurse!

Study anatomy, physiology, the foundations of health, pharmacology, health assessment, long-term, rehabilitative, medical and surgical care, obstetrics, pediatrics, mental health, addictions and more. Standard First Aid/CPR Healthcare Provider 'C' AED, TLR and WHMIS along with clinical practice and practicums are included.

When you graduate, you'll be eligible to write the Canadian Practical Nursing Registration Exam and be able to pursue one of the numerous opportunities available in acute-care, rehab-care, long-term care, homecare and medical centres.

This program is approximately 76 weeks long, offered over two years.

You'll need Grade 12 with a min. avg. of 65% in ELA A30, ELA B30, FDN MATH 30 or PRE CALC 30 or W&A MATH 30; one of BIO 30, CHEM 30 or PHYS 30; and one of SOC STU 30, HIS 30 or NS 30 & English Language Requirement (specific to Practical Nursing).

You'll be required to provide evidence of a Criminal Record Check, a Vulnerable Sector Search, N95 respirator mask testing and immunization records to meet program requirements.

Train for an exciting career in delivering pre-hospital emergency care.

Learn how to perform physical assessments, recognize and manage medical and mental health issues, trauma injuries, obstetrical, cardiac and respiratory emergencies, and more. Plus, you'll learn how to administer IV and medications. CPR Heart Saver 'C' AED/ Standard First Aid, TLR and WHMIS training are included.

When you graduate, you'll be eligible to write the licensing exam for registration with the Saskatchewan College of Paramedics and pursue employment opportunities at ambulance, air ambulance and fire protection services or at mining, manufacturing, milling or processing sites around the province.

This program is approximately 51 weeks long for a full-time program.

You'll need Grade 12 with a min. avg. of 60% in ELA A30, ELA B30, one of BIO 30 or CHEM 30, and one of W&A MATH 30 or FDN MATH 30 or PRE CALC 30 & English Language Requirement (program specific).

You'll be required to provide evidence of a Criminal Record Check, a Vulnerable Sector Search, N95 respirator mask testing and immunization records to meet program requirements.

You must exhibit physical strength and fitness consistent with the requirements of professional practice.

Make a difference for clients suffering from mental health issues and addictions. This is the first year of the Mental Health and Addictions Counselling (formerly Addictions Counselling) Diploma Program.

Some of the topics you'll study include Responsibilities and Ethics, Mental Health First Aid, Psycology, Subtance Use and Disorder Patterns, Addictions, Detoxification Processes and more.

When you complete Year 2 of the diploma, you'll be able to apply some of your clinical practice education hours as recognized clinical supervision to achieve full CACCF certification as a mental health and addictions counsellor or prevention worker.

You'll need Grade 12 with ELA A30 and ELA B30. If you are accepted, you'll be asked to provide a satisfactory Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Sector Search and current immunization records.

Funding may be available.

If you have good people skills, integrity, professionalism and a desire for a rewarding career protecting people, property and other assets, then consider becoming a security officer.

Gain practical knowledge and develop skills in crime prevention, control tactics, interpersonal communication, conflict resolution and mental health first aid. Learn about personal wellness, security officer legislation, procedures, protocols, reporting and more. Then, you'll write the licensing exam that is required by the Ministry of Justice to allow you to work as a security officer.

You'll then be prepared to pursue employment opportunities as a security officer at mine sites, industrial plants, entertainment venues, health care facilities, casinos, shopping malls and more.

This program is approximately 12 weeks long.

You'll need Grade 10, English Language Requirement and a satisfactory Criminal Record Check.

Carlton Trail College drives significant economic activity within its east-central learning area, contributing a documented \$10.8 million to the regional economy in 2017 – a number that's only grown as the College has evolved to meet the province's workforce training needs!

Take the first step towards a career in agriculture. This certificate program focuses on crop production and allows you to master skills essential for modern agricultural operations.

Topics include Plant Science and Field Crops, Soil Science, Tillage and Direct Seeding Systems, and Weed and Herbicide Management. Plus, you'll learn about Computer Applications, Business Records and Reporting, Grain Marketing, and more. This program includes face-to-face, virtual, and hands-on learning.

Upon completion, you'll have the opportunity to transfer into year two of Lakeland's Crop Technology Diploma program, offered in Vermilion or enter the workforce in the retail agriculture sector or a farming operation.

This program is approximately 7 months long.

You'll need Grade 12 with a minimum of 50% in ELA A30 & ELA B30, FND MATH 20 or PRE-CAL 20, one 20 level core Science & English Language Requirement.

You'll cover topics such as site layout, construction documents, building materials, foundations, framing, trusses and more. You'll also develop additional skills in the work experience component.

When you graduate, you'll be prepared for a variety of entry-level employment opportunities with residential or industrial construction companies.

Trade time and academic credit may be available to graduates who find employment in the trade and register as an apprentice.

The program is approximately 19 weeks long.

You'll need Grade 10 & English Language Requirement.

Learn how to install, test, replace and repair lighting fixtures, wiring and electrical equipment, and how to read and interpret construction drawings. Plus, you'll get plenty of hands-on practice using standard tools of the trade.

When you graduate, you'll be prepared for an entry-level job as an apprentice in the trade.

Trade time and academic credit may be available for graduates who find employment in the trade and register as an apprentice.



Industrial Mechanics

Sask Polytechnic Applied Certificate



If you like working with machinery, enjoy solving mechanical problems, and are good with your hands, consider a career as an Industrial Mechanic.

Industrial Mechanics (also known as maintenance mechanics, millwrights, or machine repairmen) install, repair, overhaul, and maintain stationary industrial machinery and mechanical equipment.

Learn about drafting and blueprint reading, tool use, basic welding, fabrication and installation, pumps, mechanical components, preventative maintenance, safety and more.

When you graduate, you'll be prepared to work on machines in a wide variety of commercial or industrial operations such as mines, mills, refineries, power generating plants, and wood, cereal, or meat processing plants.

Trade time and academic credit may be available for graduates who find employment in the trade and register as an apprentice.

This program is approximately 17 weeks long.

You'll need Grade 12 with FDN MATH 20 or PRE CALC 20 & English Language Requirement.

Plumbing and Pipefitting

Sask Polytechnic Applied Certificate

If you love working with your hands, the Plumbing and Pipefitting Applied Certificate Program can help launch you into a career in the trades.

Plumbers install, replace and maintain water and sewage systems in residential, commercial and industrial buildings. Many are also licensed gas fitters.

This program provides entry-level practical knowledge and skill development in plumbing installation, water supplies, waste systems, and plumbing fixtures.

You'll need Grade 11 and need to meet the English Language Requirement.

When you graduate, you'll be prepared for a variety of entry-level employment opportunities with plumbing contractors and construction companies, as well as with maintenance departments in power, mining or manufacturing companies.

Trade time and academic credit may be available to graduates who find employment in the trade and register as an apprentice.

The program is approximately 17 weeks long.

Welding

Sask Polytechnic Applied Certificate



Gain the knowledge and skills you need to weld. You'll get hands-on instruction in general shop practice and shop safety, plus learn about oxy/acetylene fusion welding, cutting processes, gas metal arc welding (MIG), and shielded metal arch (stick) welding. You'll also develop additional skills in the work experience component.

When you graduate, you'll be prepared for an entry-level job in a variety of industries.

Trade time and academic credit may be available for graduates who find employment in the trade and register as an apprentice.

This program is approximately 21 weeks long.

Journeyperson Upgrader Program

Prepare for your written and practical Journeyperson Welding Exams. Saskatchewan Apprenticeship Exams are included in the course dates. When you complete this program, you'll be prepared for your Journeyperson Welding Exams.

This part-time program is 18 weeks long.

You must have at least 4 1/2 years and 8,100 hours (including 900 MIG and 900 Stick, minimum) welding experience.

HUMBOLDT: Starts November 2024 (Classes run Wednesday evenings & Saturdays.)

This program includes theory, safety tickets, and hands-on training on real equipment at a job site just outside of Prince Albert. You'll train on two pieces of equipment which may include the crawler tractor, excavator, front-end loader or motor grader. You'll also earn safety tickets such as First Aid/CPR'C' and Ground Disturbance II.

When you complete this program, you'll be prepared to operate heavy equipment in the construction, pipeline, or mining industry.

This program is approximately 5 weeks long.

You must be 17 years of age or older and hold a valid Class 5 Driver's Licence.
