The College shall cooperate with the University of Saskatchewan and the University of Regina in the delivery of credit programs in the Carlton Trail region.

Carlton Trail College may provide university programming where an identified need exists and where St. Peter's College is unable, or chooses not, to address that need.

The conditions of delivery shall be as per the agreement regulating delivery of university credit programs through Regional Colleges.

Tuition fees shall be at those rates established by the respective university.
