# 2.1 Peavey Mart Building Summary

### 2.2 Structural Review Report

Presented by CEO Yeager and received for information. The following items were noted:

- Support beam reinforcement may be required due to checking (cracking) observed in the wooden beams.
- Minimal cracking observed on concrete flooring.

#### 2.3 Acquisition and Renovation Business Case Draft

Presented by CEO Yeager and received for information. CEO Yeager presented the proposed stages involved if the Peavey Mart building was to be purchased. At earliest, programming could begin within the building by January 2026.

#### 2.5 Next Steps – Review and Discussion

Each Board member was given the opportunity to ask questions and express any concerns about the potential purchase, allowing for a clearer understanding of any associated risks before determining if and how to move forward with a decision.

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In regard to zoning bylaws for the property, Director Dieno noted the City of Humboldt's Discretionary Use Bylaw, Section 3.10.4(3), which states the following:

The proposal must demonstrate that noise, odour, dust, lighting, glare, vibrations, emissions, hazardous substances, etc. are not detrimental to the health, safety, convenience or general welfare of persons residing or working in the vicinity or injurious to property, improvements or potential development in the vicinity.

Motion 07-25-02:

Paproski, that the Carlton Trail College Board of Directors approve the College's intent to purchase by submitting a conditional offer for the Peavey Mart building in Humboldt, subject to satisfactory financial review, confirmation of funding availability and zoning, inclusion of appropriate conditions in the offer, and obtaining legal services to write the offer to purchase.
