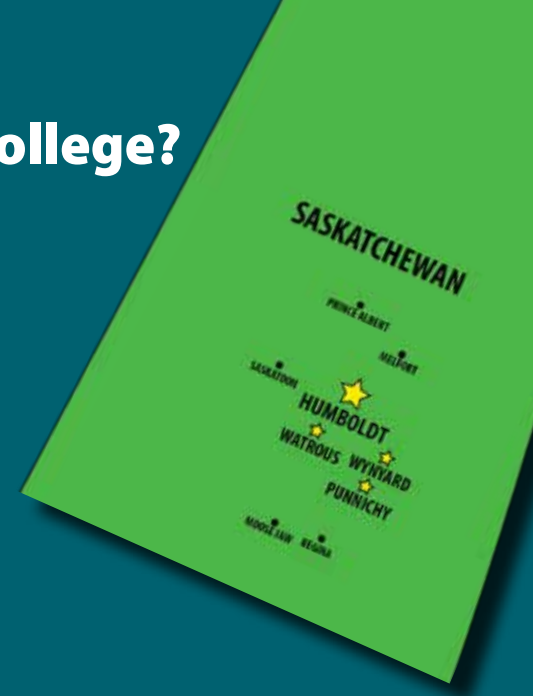

Sask Polytechnic Programs and Courses

Discover how to support children as they learn through play.

When you graduate, you'll be prepared to pursue employment opportunities in a childcare centre, preschool, family day home or elementary school setting.

You'll need Grade 12 with English Language Arts A30 and B30 and to meet the English Language Requirement. You'll also need to provide evidence of a Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Sector Check prior to entering practicum placements. The Certificate of Achievement is Open Access - meaning you do not need to meet any academic or English Language entrance requirements.

Your first step to a career in business, government, healthcare or other sectors starts with the Office Administration Certificate.

Get training on the most up-to-date aspects of office administration. Learn about writing business letters and memos, keyboarding, basic accounting, reception, communication, records management, scheduling, and more. Plus, you'll develop your computer skills in word processing, spreadsheets, databases, presentations, and automated accounting. Practice in class, then develop your skills further during the work experience component at the end of the program.

When you graduate, you'll be prepared to enter the workforce as a receptionist, administrative assistant, customer service representative, bookkeeper or other positions that requires office administration skills.

This program is approximately 35 weeks long.

You'll need Grade 12 and to meet the English Language Requirement.

Continuing Care Assistant

Sask Polytechnic Certificate

Continuing Care Assistants are special people!

Learn how to support clients who depend on you. Topics covered include gerontology, dementia management, administering personal care, medication monitoring, and more. You'll also receive Standard First Aid/CPR C/AED training or equivalent, WHMIS training and participate in a clinical work experience.

When you graduate, you'll be prepared to pursue one of the hundreds of employment opportunities available for CCA's in long-term care, private-care, homecare, and other healthcare settings.

This program is approximately 32 weeks long.

You'll need Grade 12 and/or successful completion of 15 post-secondary credits from a recognized institution and meet the English Language Requirement. You'll also be required to provide evidence of a Criminal Record Check, a Vulnerable Sector Search and Immunization Records to meet program requirements.

This program is offered at multiple locations. The Humboldt campus delivers the program in-person, while other locations offer a blended format combining in-person and online learning.

Practical Nursing

Sask Polytechnic Diploma

Practical Nurses are in high demand! If you want to help people and have a career with many opportunities, consider becoming a Practical Nurse!

Study anatomy, physiology, the foundations of health, pharmacology, health assessment, long-term, rehabilitative, medical and surgical care, obstetrics, pediatrics, mental health, addictions and more. Standard First Aid/CPR Healthcare Provider 'C' AED, TLR and WHMIS along with clinical practice and practicums are included.

When you graduate, you'll be eligible to write the Canadian Practical Nursing Registration Exam and be able to pursue one of the numerous opportunities available in acute-care, rehab-care, long-term care, home-care and medical centres.

This program is approximately 76 weeks long, offered over two years.

You'll need Grade 12 with a min. avg. of 65% in ELA A30, ELA B30, FDN MATH 30 or PRE CALC 30 or W&A MATH 30; one of BIO 30, CHEM 30 or PHYS 30; and one of SOC STU 30, HIS 30 or NS 30 and an English Language Requirement specific to Practical Nursing (IELTS). You'll be required to provide evidence of a Criminal Record Check, a Vulnerable Sector Search, N95 respirator mask testing and immunization records to meet program requirements.

Primary Care Paramedic

Sask Polytechnic Certificate

Train for an exciting career in delivering pre-hospital emergency care. Learn how to perform physical assessments, recognize and manage medical and mental health issues, trauma injuries, obstetrical, cardiac and respiratory emergencies, and more. CPR Heart Saver 'C' AED/ Standard First Aid, TLR and WHMIS training are included.

When you graduate, you'll be eligible to write the licensing exam for registration with the Saskatchewan College of Paramedics and pursue employment opportunities at ambulance, air ambulance and fire protection services or at mining, manufacturing, milling or processing sites.

This program is approximately 51 weeks long for a full-time program.

You'll need Grade 12 with a min. avg. of 60% in ELA A30, ELA B30, one of BIO 30 or CHEM 30, and one of W&A MATH 30, FDN MATH 30 or PRE CALC 30 and an English Language Requirement - specific to Primary Care Paramedic - (IELTS). You'll also be required to provide evidence of a Criminal Record Check, a Vulnerable Sector Search, N95 respirator mask testing and Immunization Records to meet program requirements.

You must exhibit physical strength and fitness consistent with the requirements of professional practice.

Sask Polytechnic Applied Certificate

Do you like building things and want a career in the construction industry?

The Carpentry Applied Certificate program will teach you the basics of carpentry and help you develop your skills for a career in residential, commercial, construction and other related industries. You'll cover topics such as blueprints and quantity surveys, concrete, foundations, framing, scaffolding and more. Practice in class, then develop your skills further during the work experience component at the end of the program!

When you graduate, you'll be prepared for an entry-level job as an apprentice in the trade. Trade time and academic credit may be available for graduates who find employment in the trade and register as an apprentice.

This program is approximately 19 weeks long.

You'll need Grade 11 with FDN MATH 20, W&A MATH 20 or PRE CALC 20. (Modified and General Math credits will not be accepted.) You'll also need to meet the English Language Requirement.

Are you looking for a career in the trades? Become an Electrician.

The Electrician Applied Certificate will provide you with the knowledge and skills for an entry-level electrician job. You'll learn how to install, test, replace and repair lighting fixtures, wiring and electrical equipment, and how to read and interpret construction drawings. Plus, you'll get plenty of hands-on practice using standard tools of the trade. Practice in class, then develop your skills further during the work experience component at the end of the program!

When you graduate, you'll be prepared for an entry-level job as an apprentice in the trade. Trade time and academic credit may be available for graduates who find employment in the trade and register as an apprentice.

This program is approximately 21 weeks long.

You'll need Grade 11 with FDN MATH 20, W&A MATH 20 or PRE CALC 20 and need to meet the English Language Requirement.

Industrial Mechanics

Sask Polytechnic Applied Certificate

If you like working with machinery, enjoy solving mechanical problems, and are good with your hands, consider a career as an Industrial Mechanic.

Industrial Mechanics (also known as Maintenance Mechanics, Millwrights, or Machine Repairmen) install, repair, overhaul, and maintain stationary industrial machinery and mechanical equipment.

Learn about drafting and blueprint reading, tool use, basic welding, fabrication and installation, pumps, mechanical components, maintenance, and more. Practice in class, then develop your skills further during the work experience component at the end of the program!

When you graduate, you'll be prepared to work as an apprentice in a wide variety of commercial or industrial operations such as mines, mills, refineries, power generating and processing plants.

Trade time and academic credit may be available for graduates who find employment in the trade and register as an apprentice.

This program is approximately 17 weeks long.

You'll need Grade 12 with FDN MATH 20, W&A MATH 20 or PRE CALC 20 and need to meet the English Language Requirement.

Learn about plumbing fixtures and installations, water supplies, waste systems, and more. Practice in class, then develop your skills further during the work experience component at the end of the program!

When you graduate, you'll be prepared for a variety of entry-level employment opportunities with plumbing contractors and construction companies, as well as with maintenance departments in power, mining or manufacturing companies.

Trade time and academic credit may be available to graduates who find employment in the trade and register as an apprentice.

This program is approximately 17 weeks long.

You'll need Grade 11 and to meet the English Language Requirement.

You must have at least 4 1/2 years and 8,100 hours (including 900 MIG and 900 Stick, minimum) welding experience.

Gain the knowledge and skills you need to weld by getting hands-on instruction in general shop practice and shop safety, plus learn about oxy/acetylene fusion welding, cutting processes, gas metal arc welding (MIG), and shielded metal arc (stick) welding. Practice in class, then develop your skills further during the work experience component.

When you graduate, you'll be prepared for an entry-level job in a variety of industries. Welders are in high demand in oil and gas, mining, manufacturing and construction.

Trade time and academic credit may be available for graduates who find employment in the trade and register as an apprentice.

This program is approximately 21 weeks long.

You'll need Grade 10 and to meet the English Language Requirement.

You'll train on two pieces of equipment which may include the crawler tractor, excavator, front-end loader, or motor grader. You'll also earn safety tickets such as First Aid/CPR 'C' and Ground Disturbance II.

When you complete this program, you'll be prepared to operate heavy equipment in the construction, pipeline, or mining industry.

This program is approximately 5 weeks long.

You must be 17 years of age or older and hold a valid Class 5 Driver's Licence.

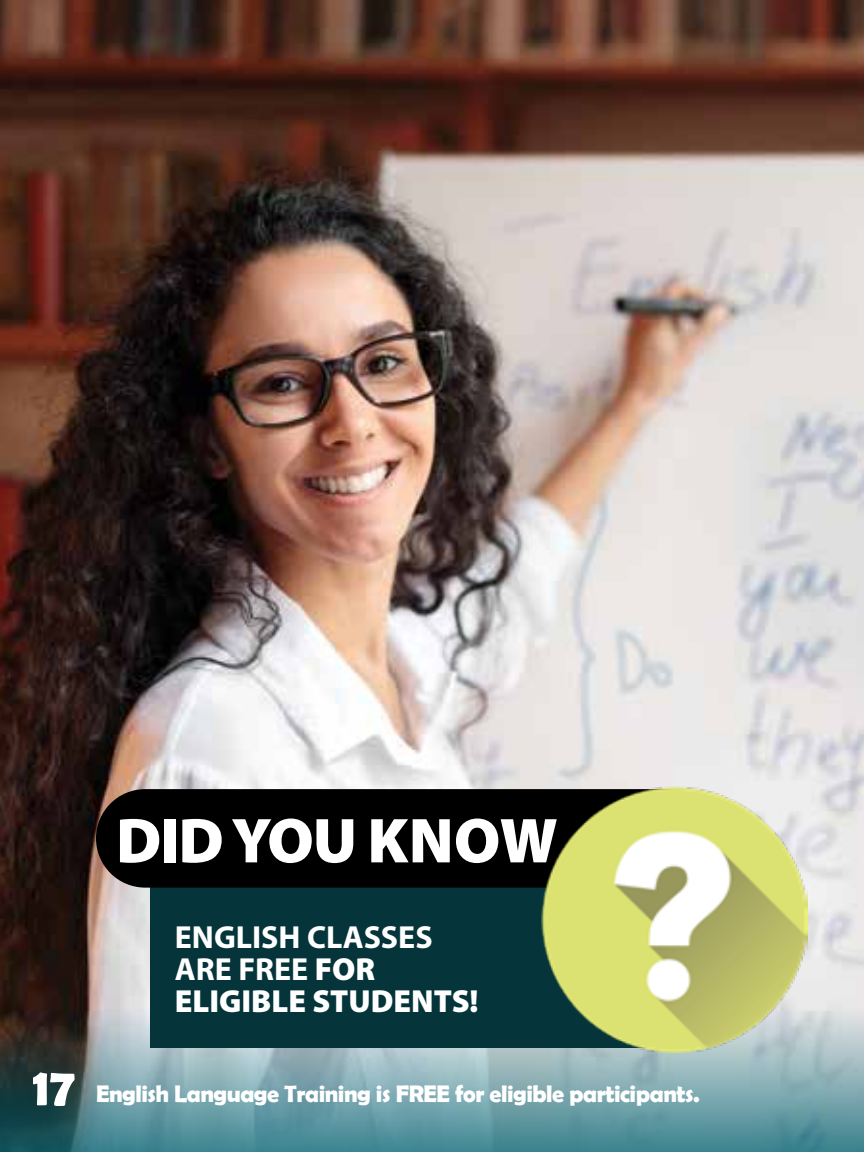
